"BLESSED ARE THOSE WHO WALK IN THE LAW OF THE LORD"

Six years ago the Church year was designated as "The Year of the Word", and the Pope Francis wanted us to renew our love of the Holy Scriptures and to listen again to the voice of God in them. At the end of January this year, the Sunday was themed as "Sunday of the Word of God" but we had a visit from the Missionary Society of St Paul so I postponed this theme.

This has inspired me to make "The Word of God" a theme for Lent this year. I will be saying more about it week by week, but meanwhile encourage you to try to devote more time to reading Holy Scripture in Lent this year, on top of any other prayers and actions that you undertake.

I wonder if Holy Scripture has been avoided at times because people are afraid of the warnings and challenges it might make? The American writer Mark Twain once commented, "It ain't those parts of the Bible that I can't understand that bother me; it is the parts that I do understand."

Today's Gospel reading is certainly challenging. Jesus preached love and forgiveness to people and must have attracted people with his gentleness and mercy. So, he needs to remind his followers, "Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets. In fact he is very strict as he lays down the Law again. "But I say to you everyone who looks at a woman with lustful intent has already committed adultery with her in his heart."

Jesus certainly wants us to keep the Law. But he wants us to go beyond it. In Lent, we have the opportunity to deepen our faith again, and go beyond just keeping the letter of the Law.

GOSPEL: MATTHEW 5:17-37

At that time: Jesus said to his disciples, 'Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I have not come to abolish them but to fulfil them. For truly, I say to you, until heaven and earth pass away, not an iota, not a dot, will pass from the Law until all is accomplished. Therefore whoever relaxes one of the least of these commandments and teaches others to do the same will be called least in the kingdom of heaven, but whoever does them and teaches them will be called great in the kingdom of heaven. For I tell you, unless your righteousness exceeds that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven.

'You have heard that it was said to those of old, "You shall not murder; and whoever murders will be liable to judgement." But I say to you that everyone who is angry with his brother will be liable to judgement; whoever insults his brother will be liable to the council; and whoever says, "You fool!" will be liable to the hell of fire. So if you are offering your gift at the altar and there remember that your brother has something against you, leave your gift there before the altar and go. First be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift. Come to terms quickly with your accuser while you are going with him to court, lest your accuser hand you over to the judge, and the judge to the guard, and you be put in prison. Truly, I say to you, you will never get out until you have paid the last penny.

'You have heard that it was said, "You shall not commit adultery." But I say to you that everyone who looks at a woman with lustful intent has already committed adultery with her in his heart. If your right eye causes you to sin, tear it out and throw it away. For it is better that you lose one of your members than that your whole body be thrown into hell. And if your right hand causes you to sin, cut it off and throw it away. For it is better that you lose one of your members than that your whole body go into hell.

'It was also said, "Whoever divorces his wife, let him give her a certificate of divorce." But I say to you that everyone who divorces his wife, except on the ground of sexual immorality, makes her commit adultery, and whoever marries a divorced woman commits adultery.

'Again you have heard that it was said to those of old, "You shall not swear falsely, but shall perform to the Lord what you have sworn." But I say to you: Do not take an oath at all, either by heaven, for it is the throne of God, or by the earth, for it is his footstool, or by Jerusalem, for it is the city of the great King. And do not take an oath by your head, for you cannot make one hair white or black. Let what you say be simply "Yes" or "No"; anything more than this comes from evil.' The Gospel of the Lord.

PHỤNG VỤ LỜI CHÚA – BẢN DIỄN GIẢI TIẾNG VIỆT

□ Bài đọc I – Huân ca 15:15–20 (Diễn giải)

Nếu con người thật lòng muốn sống theo điều Chúa dạy, họ có thể giữ các giới răn; lòng trung tín của họ tùy thuộc vào chọn lựa tự do. Thiên Chúa đặt trước mặt con người cả điều tốt lẫn điều xấu, tựa như lửa và nước, để ai muốn hướng về điều nào thì tự do đưa tay chọn lấy. Trước mặt mỗi người là sự sống và sự chết; và điều họ quyết định sẽ trở thành phần của họ.

Sự khôn ngoan của Chúa thật lớn lao; quyền năng của Ngài mạnh mẽ và Ngài thấu suốt mọi sự. Chúa luôn dõi theo những ai kính sợ Ngài và biết rõ mọi hành động của từng người. Ngài không bao giờ dạy ai sống bất lương, và cũng không cho phép ai chọn con đường tội lỗi.

Phúc thay những ai trung thành tuân giữ huấn lệnh Chúa, và hết lòng tìm kiếm Chúa. **Đáp.**

Chúa đã ban các chỉ dẫn để chúng con cẩn trọng giữ trọn.

Ước gì con luôn vững vàng bước đi theo các thánh chỉ Ngài. **Đáp.**

Xin đối xử nhân hậu với tôi tớ Ngài để con được sống và trung thành với lời Ngài.

Xin mở mắt con để con nhận ra những điều kỳ diệu trong luật pháp Chúa. **Đáp.**

Lạy Chúa, xin dạy con hiểu đường lối các thánh chỉ Chúa, để con bền bỉ giữ trọn đến cùng.

□ Bài đọc II – 1 Côrintô 2:6–10 (Diễn giải)

Thưa anh chị em, khi nói với những người trưởng thành trong đức tin, chúng tôi giảng dạy một sự khôn ngoan—nhưng không phải thứ khôn ngoan của thế gian hay của những người quyền thế đang dần biến mất. Chúng tôi loan báo một khôn ngoan nhiệm mầu, vốn là kế hoạch Thiên Chúa đã chuẩn bị từ muôn thuở để đem lại vinh quang cho chúng ta.

Những người có quyền lực trong thời này đã không hiểu điều đó; nếu hiểu, họ đã không đóng đinh Chúa vinh hiển.

Như Kinh Thánh nói:

“Điều mắt chưa thấy, tai chưa nghe, lòng người chưa từng nghĩ tới—

Thiên Chúa đã dành cho những ai yêu mến Ngài.”

Những điều này nay được Chúa Thánh Thần mặc khải cho chúng ta; Thần Khí thấu suốt mọi điều, kể cả những chiều sâu của Thiên Chúa.

□ Tung hô Tin Mừng (Diễn giải)

Alleluia, Alleluia.

Lạy Cha là Chúa Tể trời đất, con cảm tạ Cha, vì Cha đã mặc khải những điều nhiệm mầu của Nước Trời cho những tâm hồn bé nhỏ.

Alleluia.

□ Tin Mừng – Matthêu 5:17–37 (Diễn giải)

Khi ấy, Đức Giêsu nói với các môn đệ:

Anh em đừng nghĩ Thầy đến để bãi bỏ Lễ Luật hay lời các ngôn sứ. Thầy đến không phải để phá bỏ, nhưng để kiện toàn. Thầy nói thật: trước khi trời đất qua đi, từng chi tiết nhỏ nhất của Lễ Luật cũng không mất đi cho đến khi mọi điều được hoàn tất.

Vì thế, ai coi thường dù chỉ một điều răn nhỏ nhất và dạy người khác làm như vậy sẽ là kẻ nhỏ nhất trong Nước Trời; còn ai tuân giữ và dạy người khác tuân giữ sẽ được kể là lớn lao trong Nước Trời. Thầy bảo anh em: nếu sự công chính của anh em không vượt xa sự công chính của các kinh sư và người Phariseu, anh em sẽ không được vào Nước Trời.

Anh em đã nghe dạy rằng: “Chớ giết người.” Nhưng Thầy nói: ai nuôi giận hay xúc phạm người khác đã đi vào con đường tội lỗi. Nếu anh em sắp dâng lễ vật mà nhớ ra có người bất hòa với mình, hãy đi làm hòa trước, rồi hãy trở lại dâng lễ.

Anh em cũng nghe dạy: “Chớ ngoại tình.” Nhưng Thầy nói: chỉ cần nhìn người khác với ý hướng tội lỗi trong lòng là đã phản bội sự chung thủy rồi. Thầy nhấn mạnh rằng chúng ta phải mạnh mẽ loại bỏ mọi nguyên nhân dẫn đến tội lỗi, cho dù phải hy sinh.

Về chuyện ly dị, Thầy dạy rằng ai tự ý bỏ vợ ngoại lý do tội ngoại tình sẽ đẩy người ấy vào hoàn cảnh bất trung, và ai lấy người bị ly dị cũng mắc tội.

Anh em còn nghe dạy rằng: “Đừng thề gian.” Nhưng Thầy nói: đừng thề thốt gì cả—dù dựa vào trời, đất hay chính bản thân mình. Hãy nói lời đơn sơ: “Có” thì nói “có”, “không” thì nói “không”; thêm thắt gì nữa là không thuộc về sự thiện.

Đó là lời Chúa.

Đáp: Lạy Chúa Kitô, ngợi khen Chúa.

关于离婚，耶稣教导：除了因严重不忠的原因，擅自休妻会让她陷入不忠；娶被休之妇的人也同样有罪。

你们也听过古训：「不可假誓。」但我告诉你们：根本不要发誓——不要指天，因为那是天主的宝座；不要指地，因为那是祂的脚凳；不要指耶路撒冷，因为它是大王的城；甚至不要指自己的头，因为你不能让一根头发变白或变黑。

你们的话只需简单明确：「是」就是「是」、「不是」就是「不是」；多余的言语都来自邪恶。
