The children were so excited to come to school today for Dress to Express Day to mark the end of Mental Health Awareness Week. They all looked amazing!

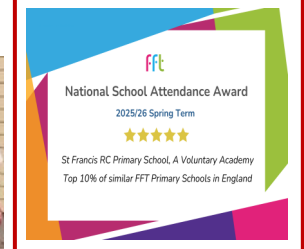
