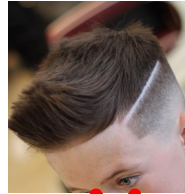


HAIRSTYLES

For health and safety reasons, all long hair should be tied back. Plain headbands and bobbles should be worn to keep hair off the face. We expect all children to have a sensible school haircut and no extreme styles, skinheads or dying of hair are permitted.

Short hair should be no shorter than a number 3. Braids plaited into the hair are not permitted for health and safety reasons.



JEWELLERY

The only jewellery that is permitted in school is a plain, inexpensive wrist watch and plain stud earrings. No necklaces, wristbands or bracelets.

MAKE UP

Pupils are not permitted to wear make up and will be asked to remove any they do wear. Nail varnish is not permitted.

PURCHASING UNIFORM

All uniform can be purchased from Gorton Market but please note that trousers, skirts and white polo shirts can be purchased cheaper elsewhere.

We have created this booklet to support you with buying the right uniform for your child. We know that there is a lot of choice and uniform can be costly so please follow our Clear guidelines to avoid any issues in the future. Our white polo shirts and black trousers and skirts should be 'school style' but can be bought from any shop or supplier.

SHOES

Both boys and girls need a pair of plain black school shoes—not boots or trainers. Please do not even consider lace ups until your child can tie their laces quickly and independently.



SCHOOL BAGS

Every child needs a red school book wallet and a draw string P.E. bag. We can store these easily in the classrooms and they are large enough to carry everything your child needs for school.



SOCKS AND TIGHTS

Black or grey or plain white socks or tights.
No labelled sports sock please.



POLO SHIRT, SKIRTS AND TROUSERS

All children should wear white short sleeved polo shirts. Trousers, skirts and pinafores should be school style and black. All children need a bright red 'jersey' style cardigan or jumper. Please go to the uniform shop in Gorton Market to purchase at least one school jumper or cardigan if you can.



PE KITS

All children need a P.E. kit that is kept in school and sent home at the end of each term for a wash. The P.E kit consists of a white round neck t-shirt, black shorts and a pair of black P.E. pumps. Older children may wear a pair of plain black trainers (please do not buy expensive designer brands) and please be mindful that they will stay in school as part of the PE kit and will not go home until half term.
