#### Year 6

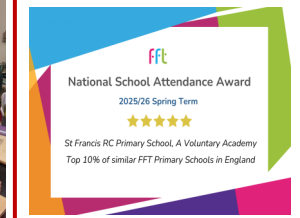
There has been much excitement in Year 6 this week as they received their Leavers' Hoodies and enjoyed an ice-cream together, to mark the start of their final half term with us.
